

INFORMATIVA FORNITORI

L.A.S.I. SRL with registered office in Meolo (VE), Via delle Industrie II 43, postcode 30020, in its capacity as data controller (hereinafter referred to as "Controller"), issues this privacy notice to the data subject, in compliance with European and Italian regulations on data protection.

Purpose and legal basis of the processing

The Data Controller processes personal data for various purposes:

- 1. to adopt pre-contractual measures requested by the Data Subject, e.g. sending information on products or services (including sending the brochure, catalogue and/or other company information material) or a quote, as well as to fulfil contractual and regulatory obligations connected with the business relationship and to pursue the legitimate interest in correctly managing the relationship itself, verifying the Data Subject's solvency and managing any disputes: the legal basis for the processing is the need to pursue the above-mentioned purposes;
- 2. to use the Data Subject's contact details (e-mail address, landline and mobile telephone number, postal address) to transmit commercial communications containing information on products or services, as well as promotions or invitations to events which the Data Controller will take part in: express consent is required for this purpose

Data storage period

The Data Controller intends to process the data according to the following time criteria:

- ▶ if information is requested, the data will be processed for the time necessary to provide feedback; if a quote is requested, however, the data will be processed for the time necessary to formulate one and subsequently for six months, without prejudice to further storage for the time necessary to settle (in whatever way) any disputes that may have arisen;
- ▶ if the Data Subject becomes a customer of the Data Controller, the data will be processed for the entire duration of the business relationship and, subsequently, to fulfil any obligations connected to, deriving from or linked to executing this relationship for a maximum period of twenty years (term related in particular to post-sales activities), without prejudice to any further storage for the time necessary to settle (in whatever way) any disputes that may have arisen;
- ▶ for the purposes referred to in point 2), the data will be processed for twenty-four months from the last communication, regardless of the channel used: the Data Subject may revoke the consent or in any case object to the processing at any time.

Nature of data provision and consequences of refusal

The provision of data is necessary and therefore any refusal to provide it in whole or in part may make it impossible for the Controller to pursue the above-mentioned purposes.

Recipient categories

The Controller will not disseminate the data, but intends to disclose it to internal figures authorised to process it based on their respective duties, as well as to credit institutions, business associations and/or organisations, professionals or service companies and public and private bodies, also following inspections and audits.

These recipients, should they process data on behalf of the Controller, will be appointed as data controllers by means of a contract or other legal deed.

Transfer of data to a third country and/or international organisation

As a rule, your personal data will not be transferred to non-European third countries.

If the Controller has business partners based outside the European Economic Area, however, the data strictly necessary for this purpose will be transferred to third countries. The Data Controller reserves the possibility of using cloud services: in this case, the providers of such services will be selected from among those who provide adequate guarantees, as provided for in section 46 GDPR.

Data subject rights

Data subjects have the right to ask the Controller to access their personal data and rectify it if it is inaccurate; erase it or restrict its processing if the conditions are met; object to its processing for legitimate interests pursued by the Controller; and obtain the portability of the data personally provided, only if it is subject to automated processing based on consent or contract. Data subjects shall also be entitled to withdraw consent for the processing purposes which require this, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing carried out until the time of withdrawal.
